Hotel Vendome: Built in 1917 it is an old Wild West historic hotel three blocks from the Court House Square, within a brisk walking distance of the Hassayampa Inn and five blocks from the Sharlot Hall Museum. We have been able to block seven rooms until September 8th. Two rooms with King Beds at \$129.00 and five rooms with queen beds at \$119.00 are available. These rooms are only available October 9th. There are some stairs and no handicapped accommodations. Very historic, quaint with a supposed resident ghost. Complimentary breakfast, Wi-Fi, off street parking.
